




Total number of records in LSHTM Research Online at 30th June 2013




Number of full-text papers deposited in LSHTM Research Online during June 2013

LSHTM Research Online traffic sources June 2013




Traffic source definitions

Search engines: visitors coming via a search engine


Referring sites: visitors referred by links on other websites
