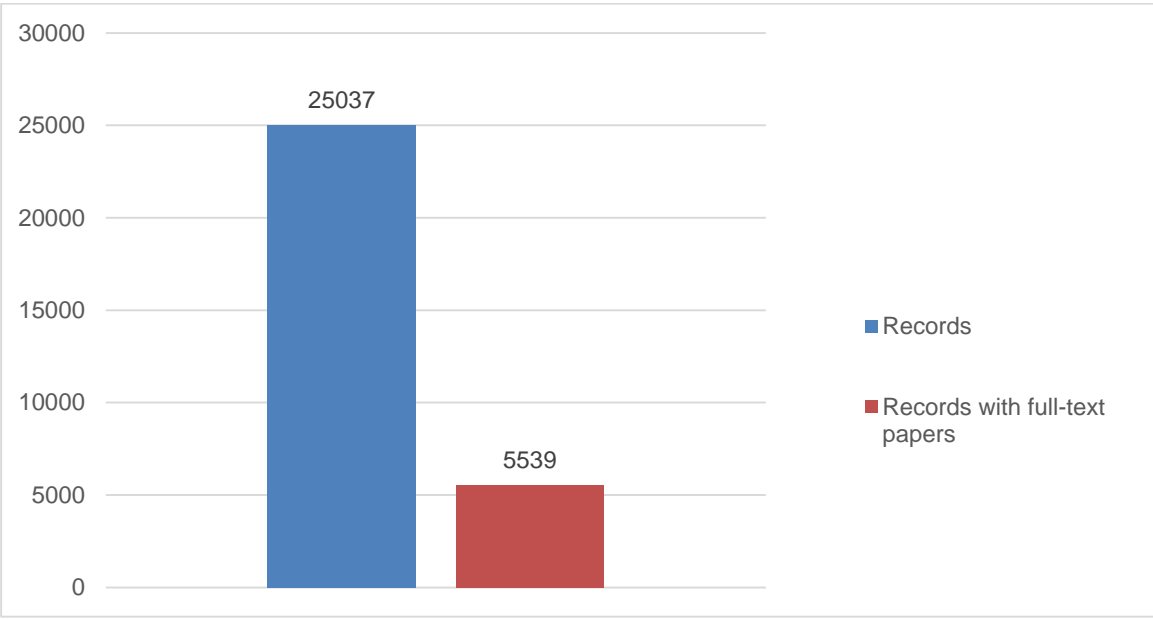

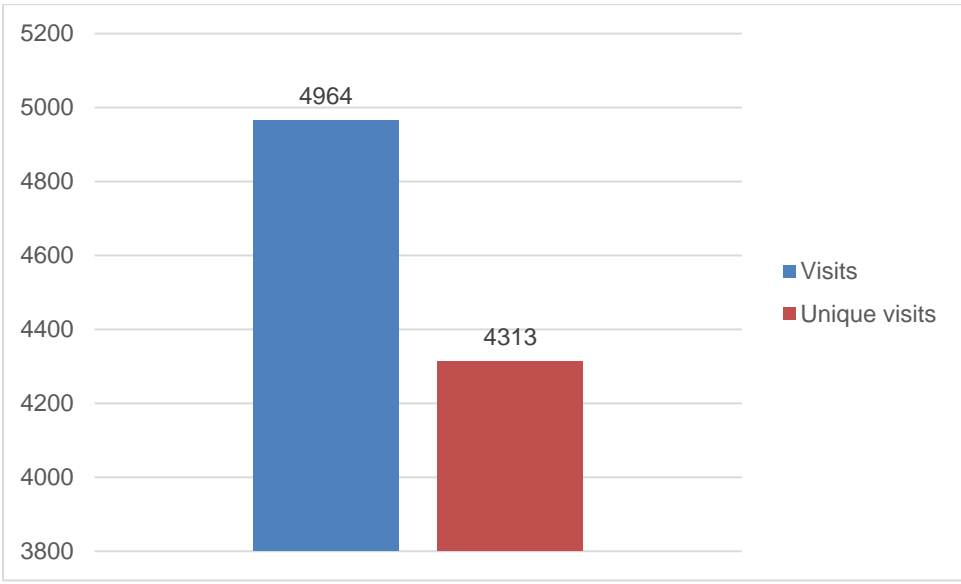

Total number of records in LSHTM Research Online at 30th April 2014

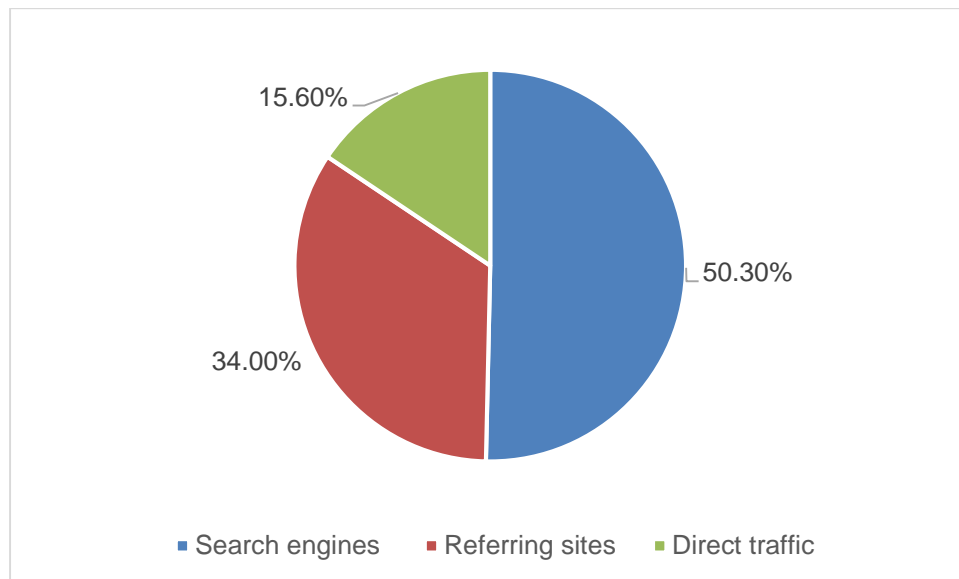


Visits to LSHTM Research Online during April 2014

April 2014



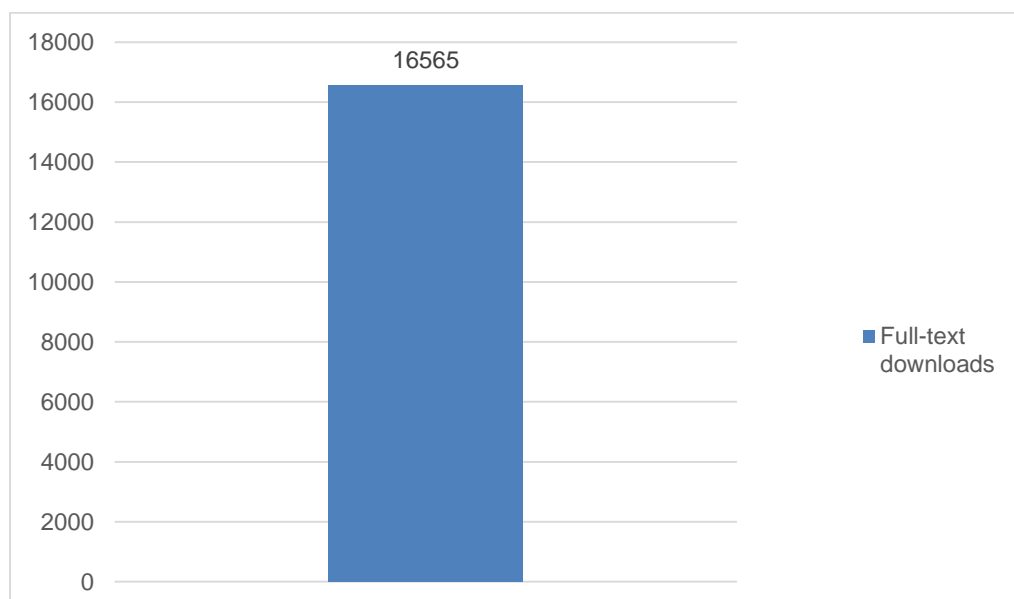
Traffic source definitions

Search engines: visitors coming via a search engine

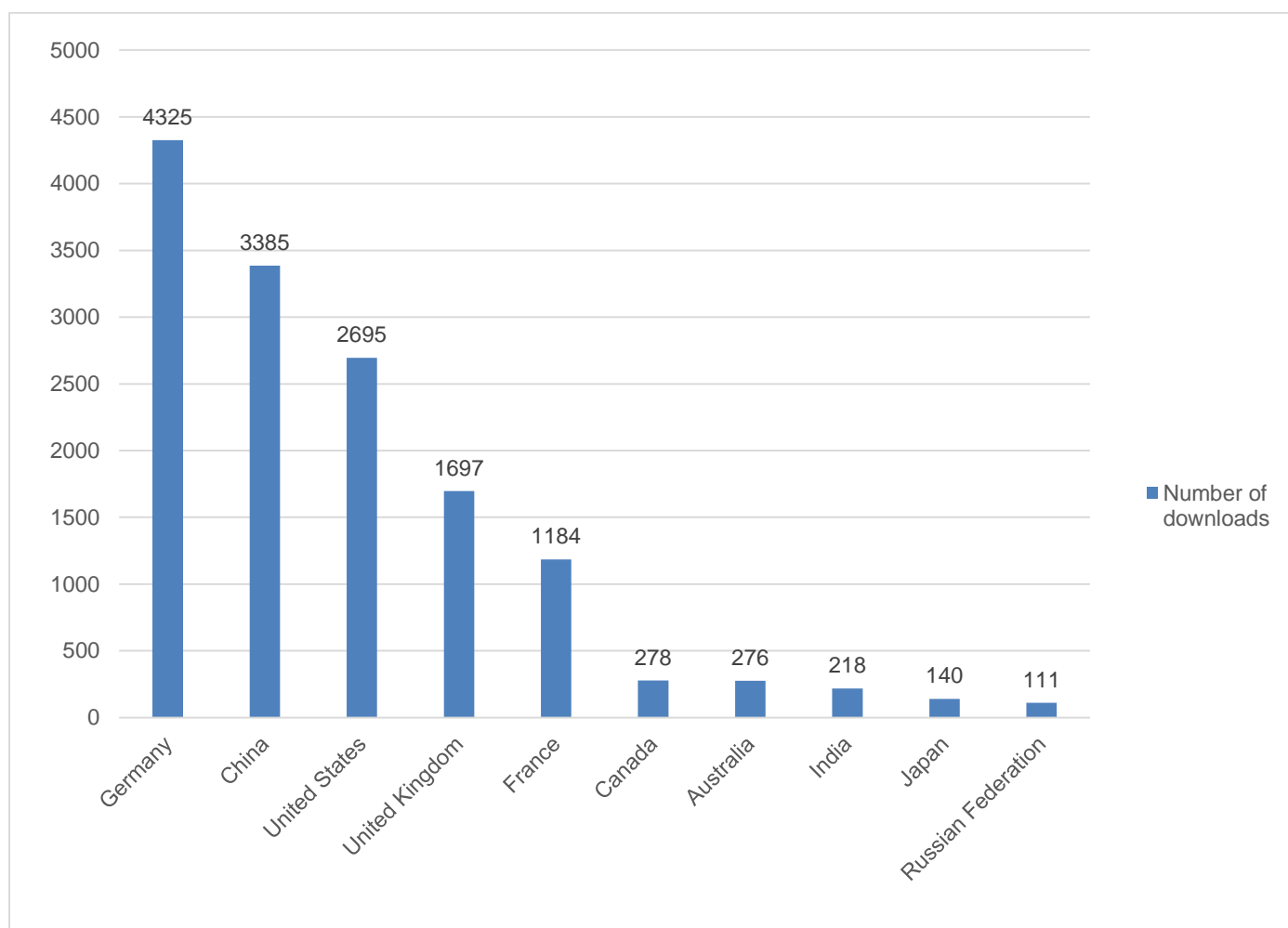
Referring sites: visitors referred by links on other websites
