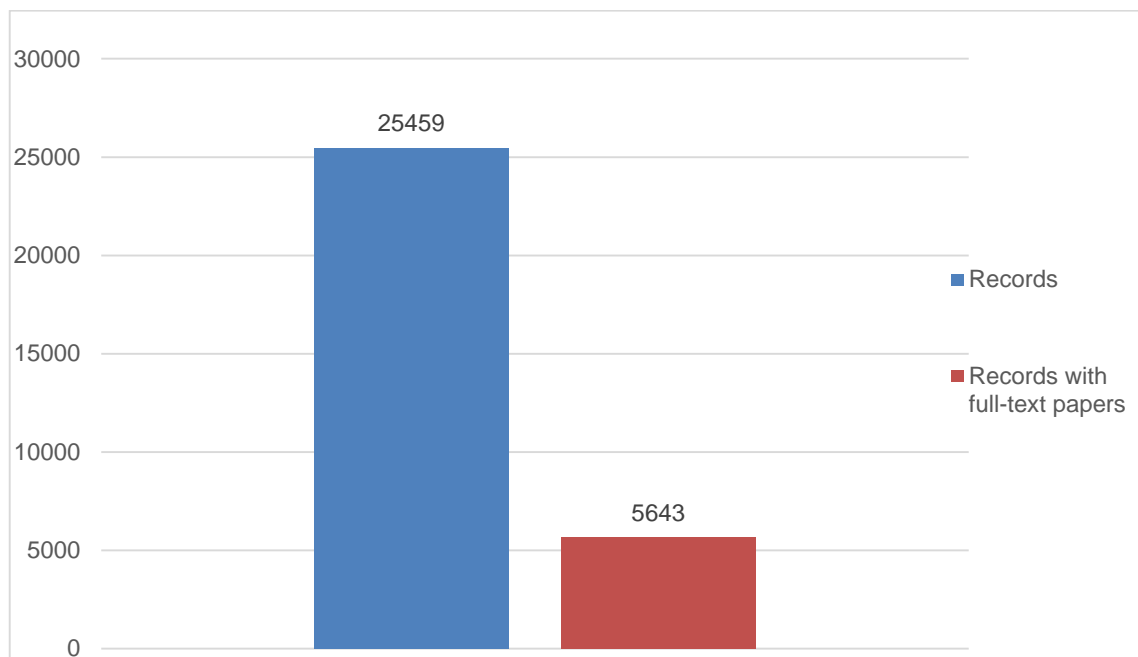

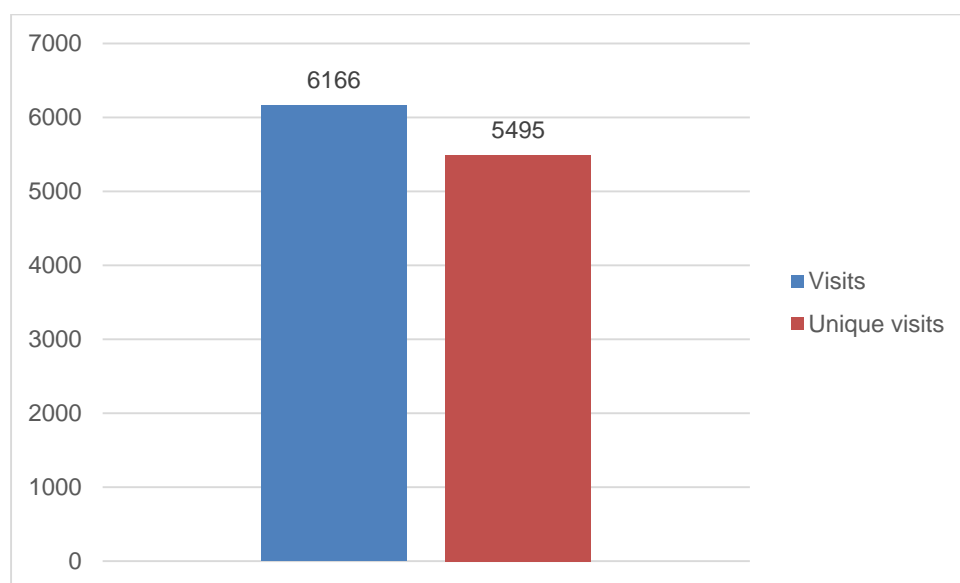

## Total number of records in LSHTM Research Online at 31st May 2014

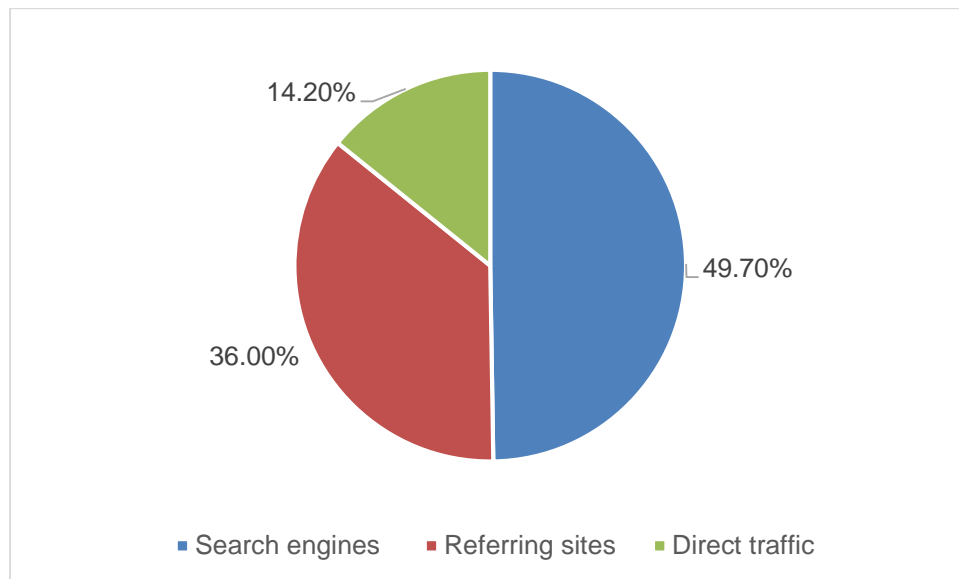


## Visits to LSHTM Research Online during May 2014

May 2014



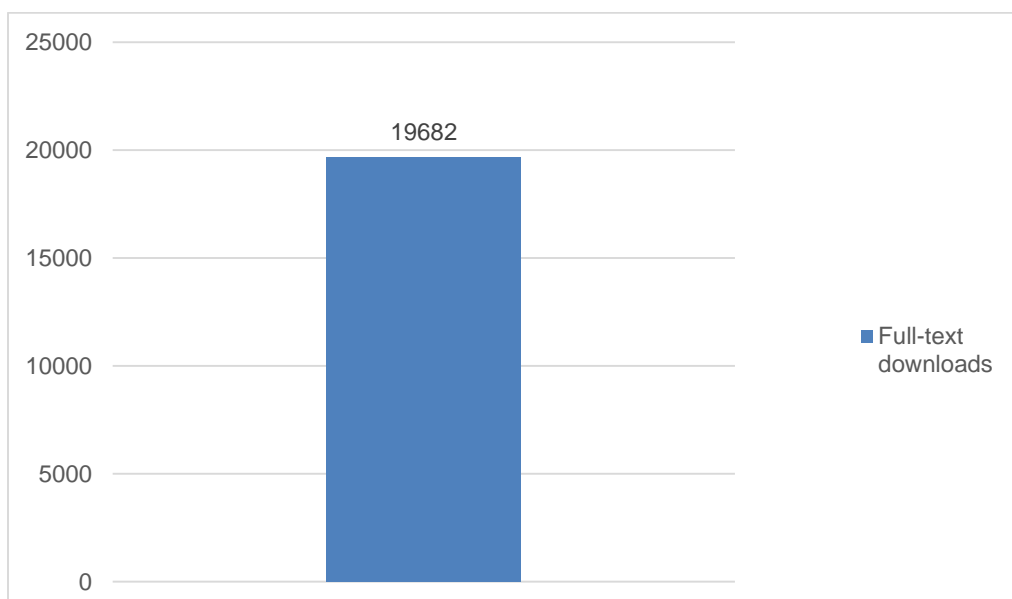
### Traffic source definitions

Search engines: visitors coming via a search engine

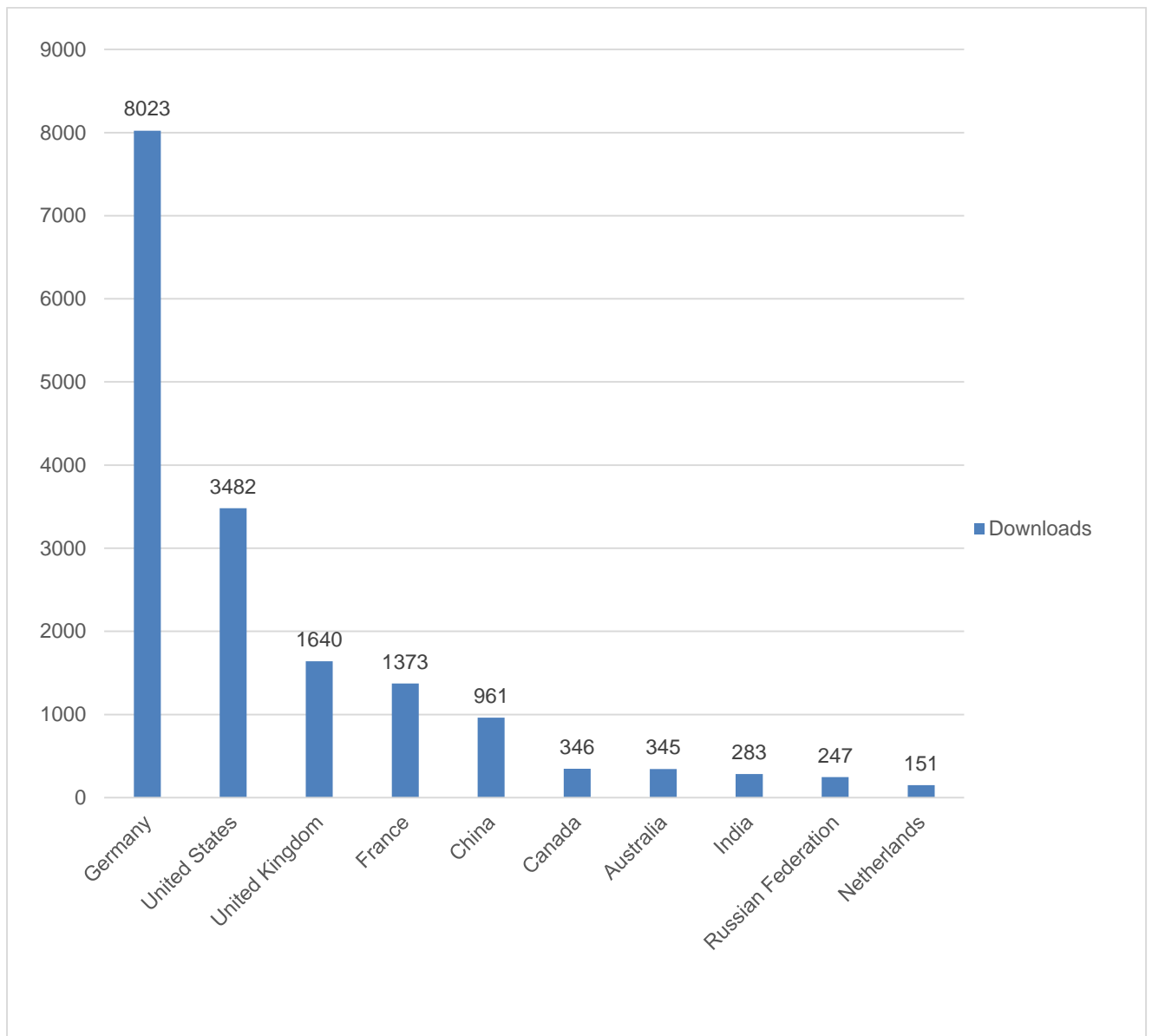
Referring sites: visitors referred by links on other websites
