<sup>c</sup> The *BMJ* requires data sharing on request as a minimum for all clinical trials.

<sup>d</sup> *PLoS Medicine* require authors to make available all data that underpin the findings described in their manuscript, with rare exception

<sup>e</sup> *BMC Medicine* strongly encourages authors to make available all data that underpin the paper's findings.
