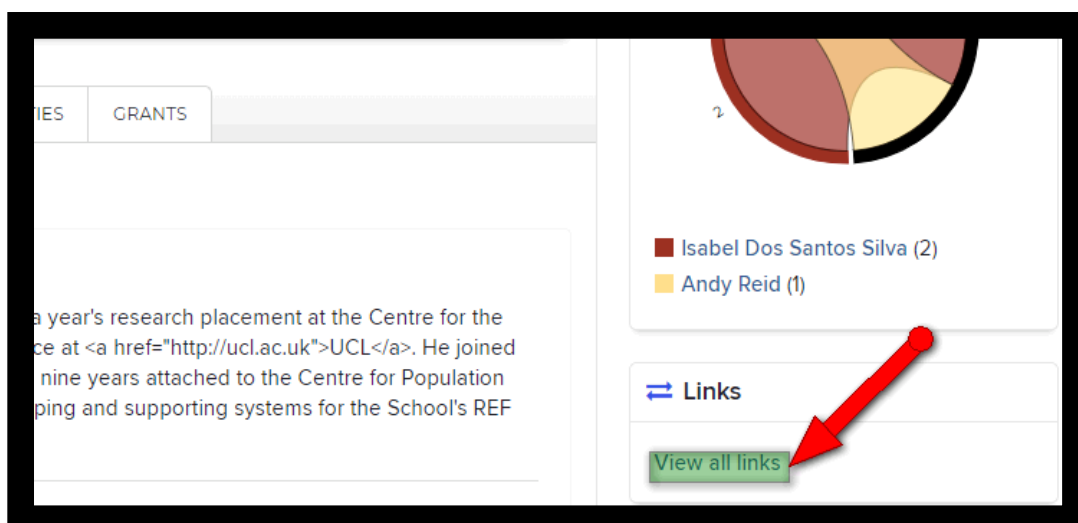


How to link yourself to a Grant

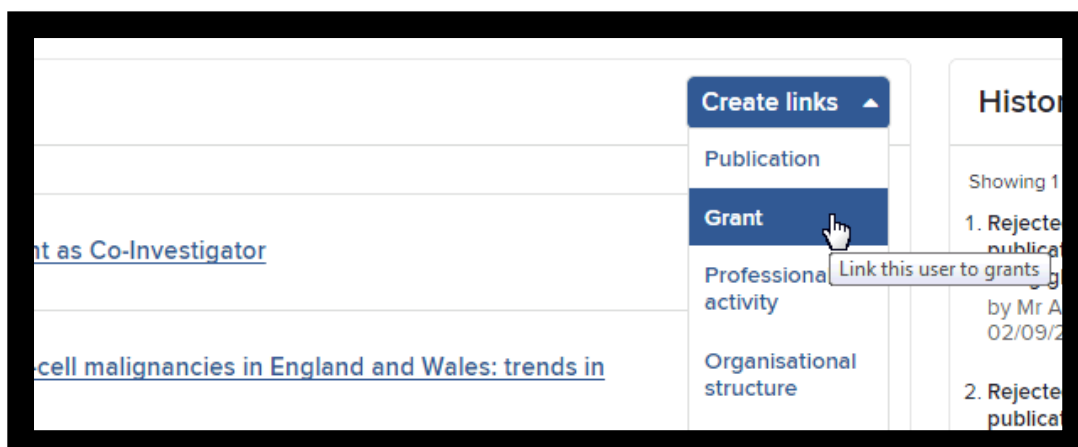
1. Go to your profile page
