




## Total number of records in LSHTM Research Online at 31st March 2013




## Number of full-text papers deposited in LSHTM Research Online during March 2013

# LSHTM Research Online traffic sources March 2013




#### **Traffic source definitions**

Search engines: visitors coming via a search engine


Referring sites: visitors referred by links on other websites
