




## Total number of records in LSHTM Research Online at 31<sup>st</sup> May 2013



## Number of full-text papers deposited in LSHTM Research Online during May 2013




Visits to LSHTM Research Online during May 2013


#### **Traffic source definitions**

Search engines: visitors coming via a search engine


Referring sites: visitors referred by links on other websites
